# Creating Product Listing

## Switch Point

You come here after completing Product Definition where you have created a new product, previewed it and assigned a **version** for your product. Furthermore, make sure that your enrolled distribution contract is approved from the Provider Portal.

## Request a Product Listing

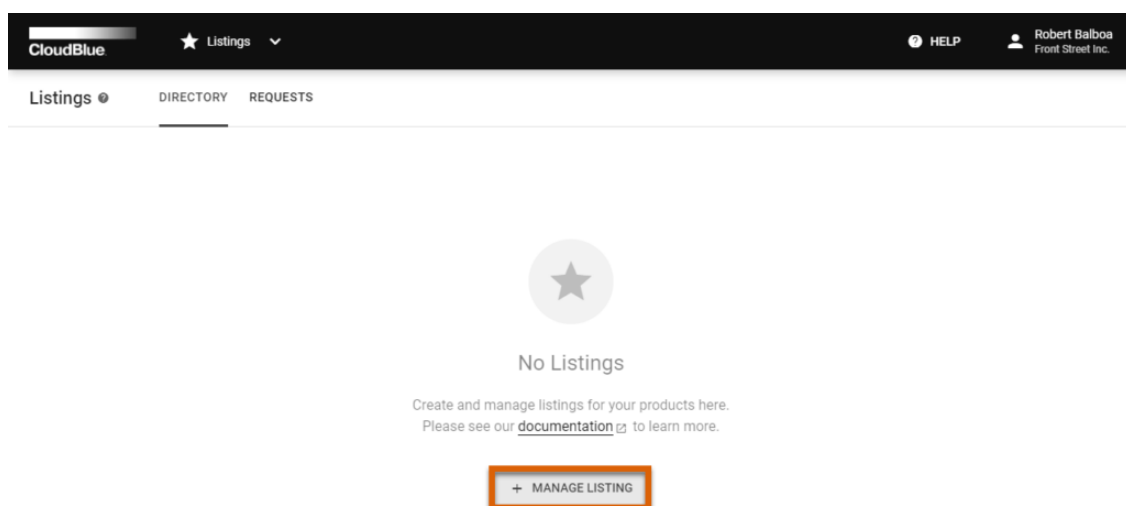


## Information

Product listings are objects in Connect representing products that are listed for sale in provider marketplaces. A vendor can request a provider to place the vendor's product listing in the provider's marketplaces.

### 1. Start creating a product listing

Proceed to the **Listing** module on the Vendor Portal:



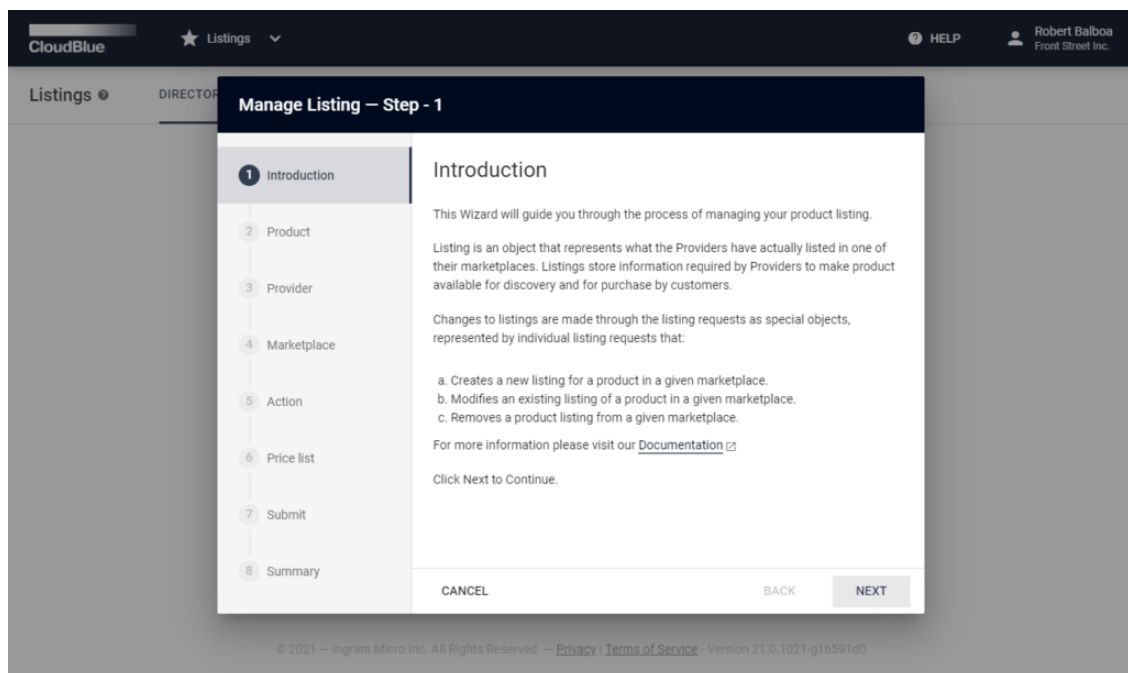
If a product version exists, this module provides a **Manage Listings** button. Otherwise, the system notifies if a product version

is not saved or distribution contract is not approved.

Click **Manage Listings** to launch a wizard.

## 2. Review the introduction

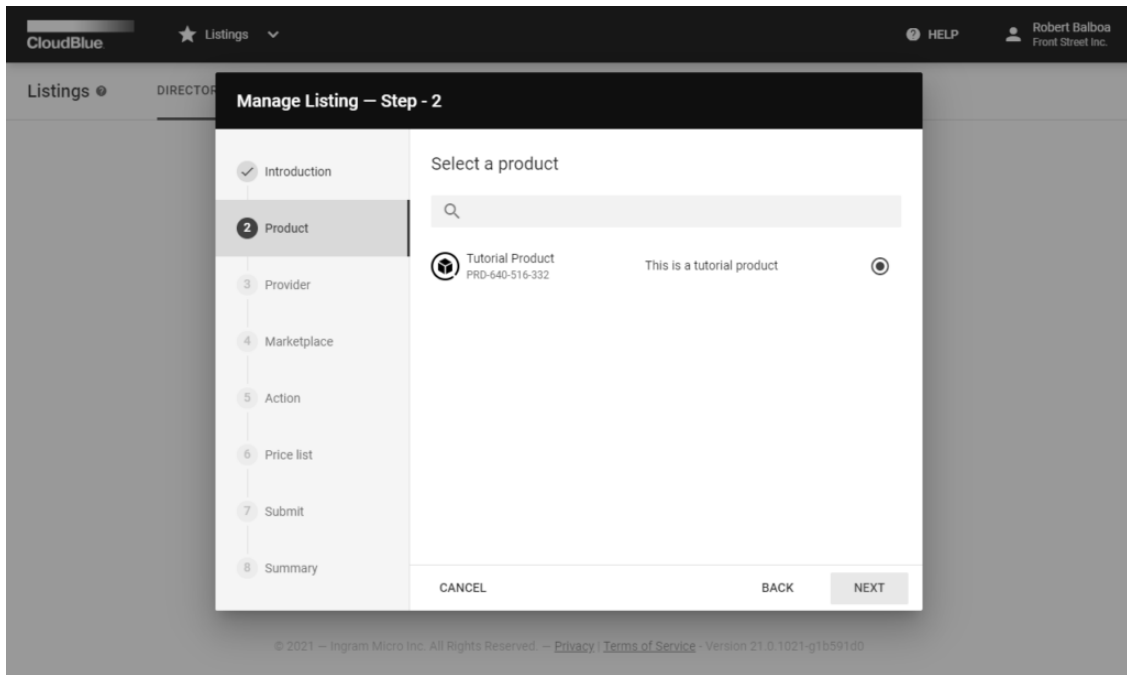
The wizard will provide an introduction that explains the product listing concept:



Click **Next** to continue.

## 3. Select your product

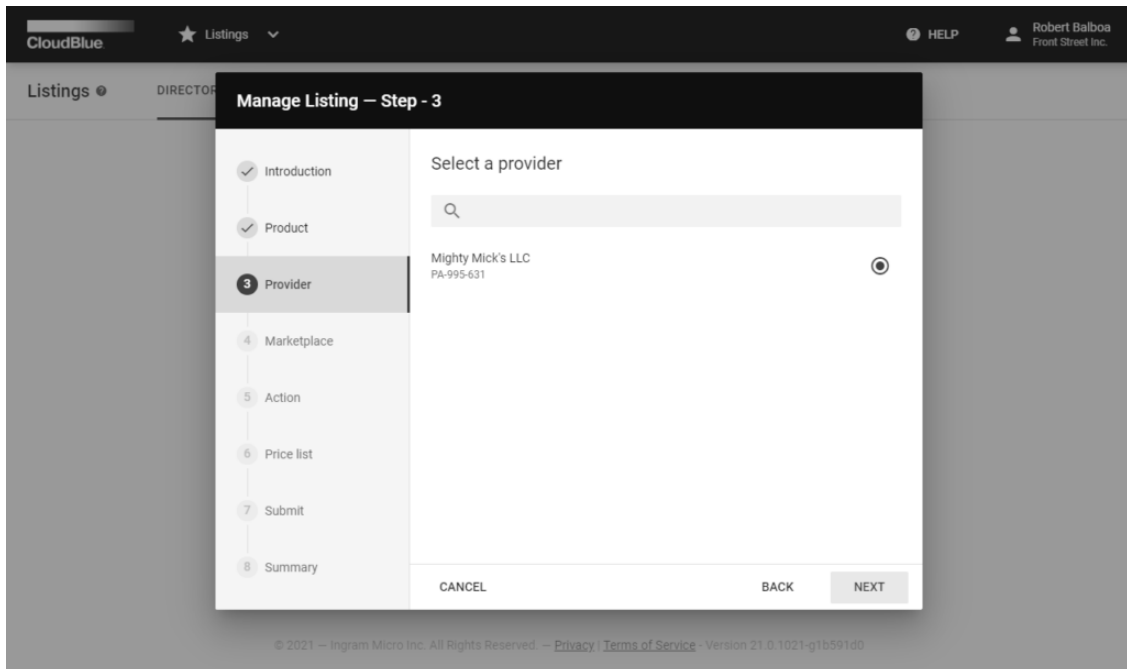
Choose your product in the following form:



Click **Next** to continue.

#### 4. Select a provider

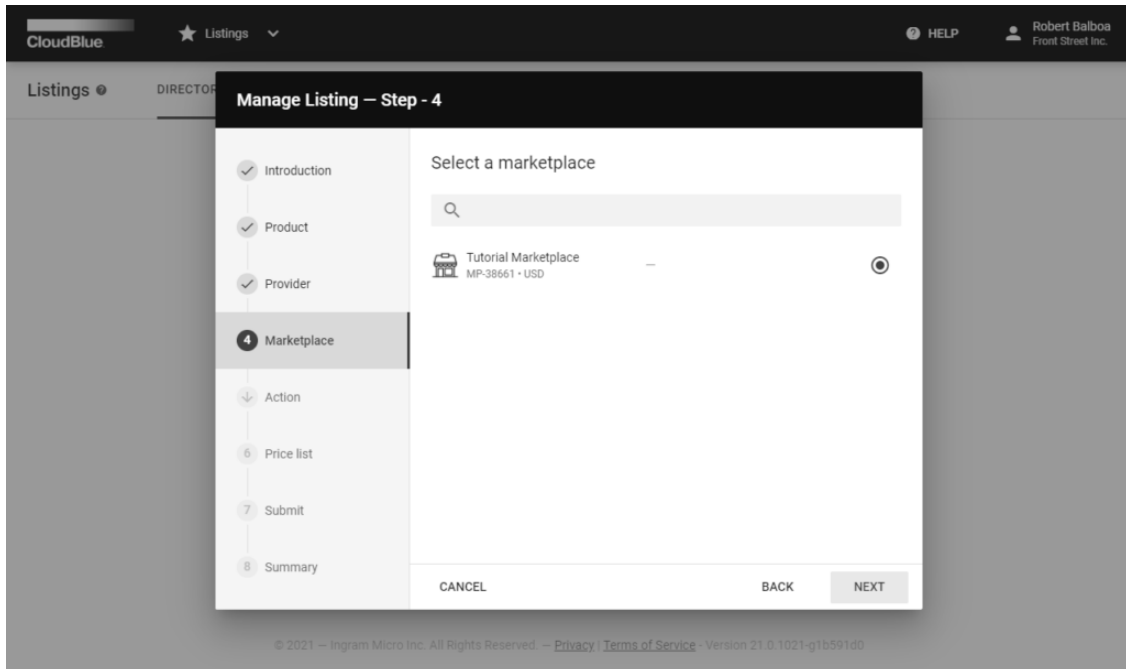
Choose a provider (owner of the marketplace you want to list the product in) in the following form:



Click **Next** to continue.

## 5. Choose a marketplace

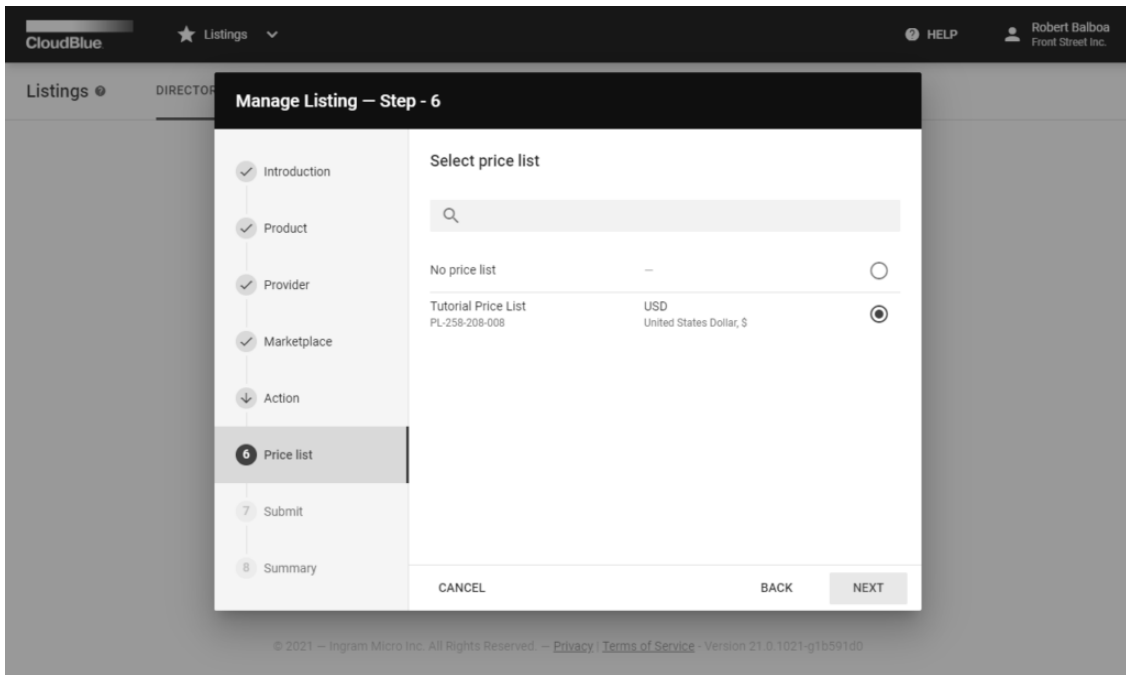
Select a marketplace you want to add your product listing to:



Click the **Next** button to continue.

## 6. Select a price list

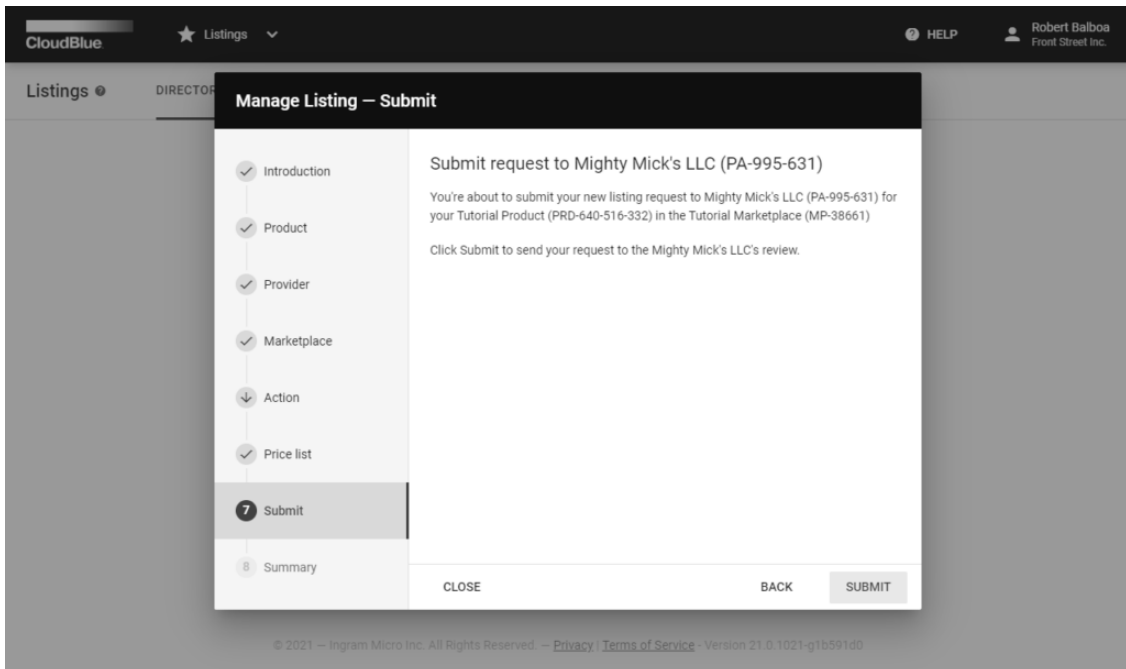
Specify a price list in the following form:



Click **Next** to continue.

## 7. Submit your request

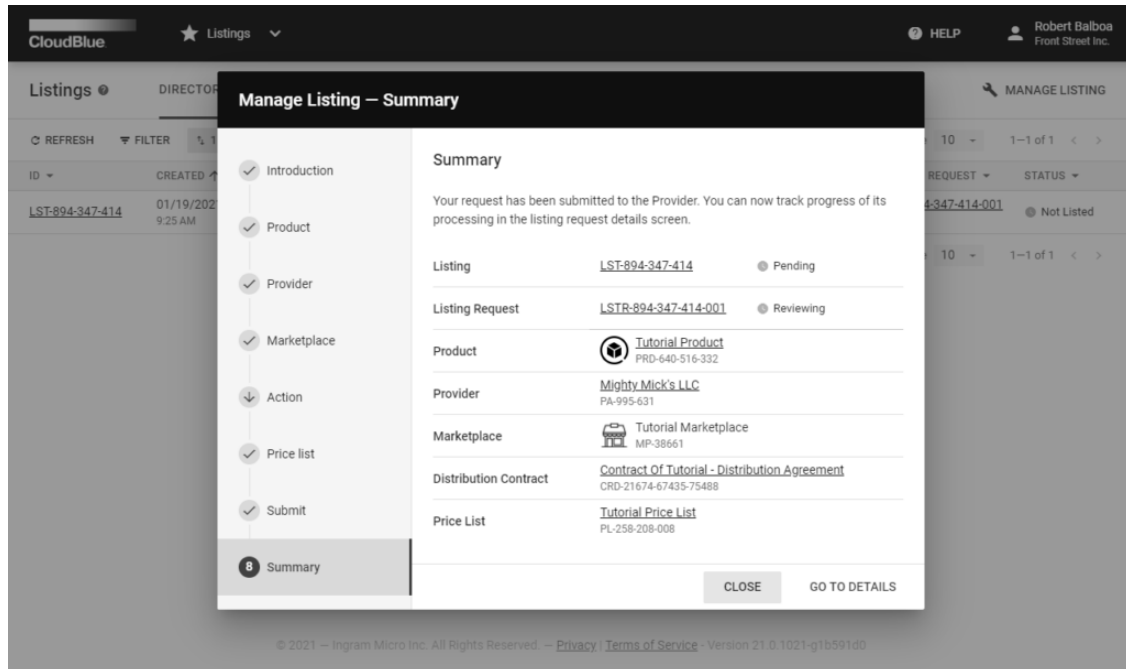
Make sure that selected marketplace and provider data are correct:



Click the **Submit** button to submit your request.

## 8. Review your listing summary

Review your created listing summary:



A pending Listing and a reviewing Listing Request objects are created. Thus, a provider will receive a notification about the pending listing request.

To complete the creation of a product listing, switch to the provider role and follow the Activating Product Listing instructions.


## Completed Product Listing Request
